



College Credit for the EXSEL Discipleship Program

We are pleased that White Sulphur Springs continues their strategic partnership with Liberty University to provide the opportunity for EXSEL Interns and Fellows to earn College Credit Hours for the successful completion of the EXSEL Discipleship Program. **With no previous college credit, an EXSEL alumni is greeted as a sophomore upon entering the university!**

Here are some details:

- Interns are able to earn up to 33 credit hours for successful completion of academic (21 hours) and experiential learning elements (12 hours) and Fellows are able to earn up to 21 credit hours for successful completion of academic (9 hours) and experiential learning elements (12 hours).
- The EXSEL program completion credential (EXSEL Transcript) is presented to the student at the completion of the program in August. Award of college credit is made when the student submits the associated EXSEL Transcript to Liberty University and is registered.
- Credit may be applied to only one undergraduate or graduate program at Liberty University.
- Credit may be transferred out of Liberty University once a degree program is completed – associates, bachelors, or graduate degree.

FAQs regarding the application of credit awarded through EXSEL to various Liberty degree programs:

Question: The credits awarded through EXSEL are for courses primarily found in the Rawlings School of Divinity. How can they be applied to a degree that is not within the Rawlings School of Divinity?

Answer: Many of the credits that the Interns can earn (denoted by the *) are applicable to all Liberty University degrees, whether it is Business Administration or Biochemistry & Molecular Biology degree. Additionally, a majority of the remaining credits can fulfill required courses for degree that are administered by the Rawlings School of Divinity (e.g. Biblical Counseling or Apologetics). Finally, most degree programs have free elective options where the student can use all of the EXSEL credit.

Question: What is the monetary value of successful completion of the EXSEL Discipleship Program?

Liberty University Undergraduate Distance-Learning General Tuition Rates (2023-2024)

Full-time per hour rate: **\$390**

Part-time per hour rate: **\$455**

Liberty University Undergraduate In-Residence General Tuition Rate (2023-2024)

Block Rate for 12-18 hours per semester: **\$11,900** (not including room & board, fees, etc.)
